

INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Securis Catastrophe Bond Fund (“SCBF” or the “Fund”) aims to generate returns and growth by investing in catastrophe bonds (“Cat Bonds”). A Cat Bond is a form of insurance linked security that transfers the risk of financial loss as a result of catastrophic events to the capital markets. The sponsors of the Cat Bonds are typically insurance companies, reinsurance companies, corporations and governments. Cat Bonds may pay fixed, floating or variable rates of interest and typically have durations between 1 and 4 years. Cat bonds may or may not be rated by an independent rating agency.

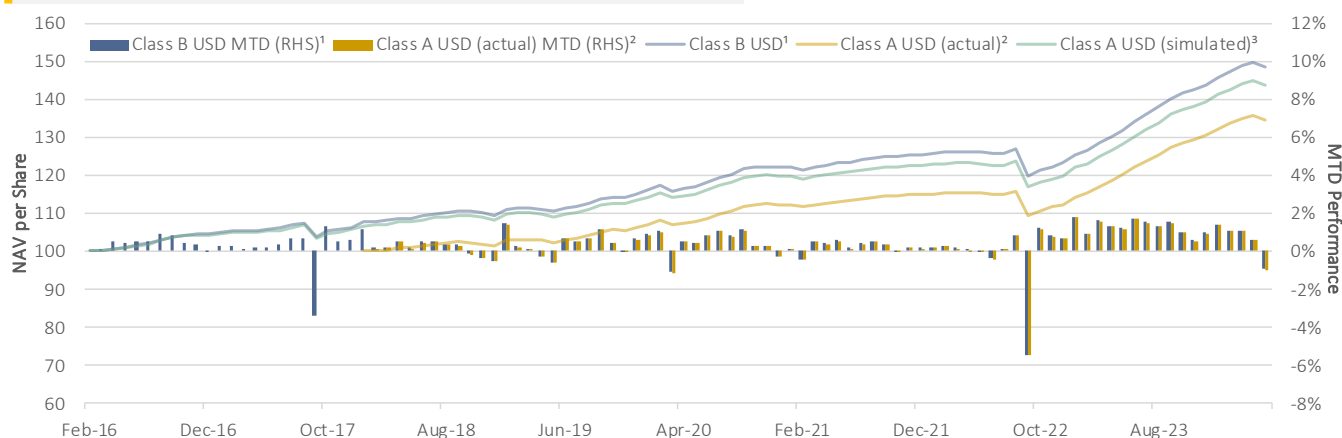

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COMMENTARY – May 2024¹

Market Context

May was characterised by widening spreads in the catastrophe bond market and was most visible for bonds linked to a predefined index of insurance industry claims (“index bonds”). The main drivers of this trend were the supply and demand imbalances that occurred during a busy period of primary issuance starting at the end of April, and the uncertainty about the upcoming hurricane season. Index bonds, having become more expensive than bonds linked to claims paid by individual sponsoring companies (“indemnity bonds”) were the first to correct. There were no major catastrophe events during the month; instead, the month’s negative return was largely driven by spread widening.

Portfolio Strategy

Regular readers of our commentary will be aware that we have been selling index bonds to manage the risk of spread convergence between expensive index bonds and cheaper indemnity bonds. However, as it has become apparent that many bonds available for purchase, in both primary and secondary markets, were acutely sensitive to developing climatic conditions, we pared back the strategy.

We are of the view that bonds covering a narrow, regional territory in the Southeast, the Gulf of Mexico, and Florida are particularly sensitive to changes in the expected frequency of hurricanes, especially in a year like this one, with record sea surface temperatures and cool phases of the ENSO cycle. Our research has indicated that a large proportion of bonds issued into the market in Q1 and early Q2 are acutely sensitive to these prevailing climatic conditions, so we have decided not to add to the portfolio.

Current indications are that index bonds have now over-corrected, evidenced by a large volume of bids emerging for these types of bonds. We expect that this will lead to upward pressure on index bond prices which will narrow the spread divergence that has emerged between index bonds and indemnity bonds. The Cat Bond market generally takes the view that indemnity bonds should trade at a discount to comparative index bonds to account for greater claims related uncertainty associated with the former, and consequently, we view excess spreads on index bonds relative to indemnity bonds as atypical.

A total of over USD three billion of new issues across 11 securities priced in May, three of which were added to the portfolio. These positions exhibit defensive characteristics, with one of these including a unique feature where returns step-up following a large hurricane in Florida (to which the bond is not exposed), thus providing a positive carry source of diversification.
